We firmly believe that sex work is a legitimate occupation and we advocate the acceptance of sex workers' rights and decriminalisation of sex work.

AFRO is a registered charitable organisation, a member of Hong Kong Women's Coalition on Equal Opportunities, the Hong Kong Coalition of AIDS Services Organizations, the Hong Kong Council of Social Service, and the Global Alliance against Traffic in Women.

▶ 報行委員會報告

Executive Committee Report

在「保護及提倡個人尊嚴及基本人權」的信念下,青鳥在 過去廿六年一直致力為性工作者心身靈健康方面給予不同範疇 的支援。去年,青鳥更獲得多個政府及非牟利基金的資助,成 功推行了多項計劃和活動,實在是對青鳥一直以來的工作的一 個肯定。基金的支持讓本會能持續地為性工作者提供多元化的 服務,包括外展、測試、熱線、個案跟進、中心活動、公眾教 育等。這些工作不僅提升了性工作者的身心健康,亦提高了她 們對自己權益的認知,更促進社會大眾對性工作者的認識和接 納。

去年本會要面對不少挑戰,包括人手不足的情況,但青鳥 團隊表現專業,在互相補足之下克服了困難。在此衷心感謝各 同工及義工,包括現已離職但在機構服務超過十年的彭詩蘊女 士,會內上下各人的付出與努力讓青鳥服務得以持續發展。 With the vision of "dignity and basic human rights should be protected and promoted", AFRO has been dedicated to providing support for sex workers in the past 26 years. Last year, AFRO received funding from various governmental and charitable funds and successfully implemented a number of programmes, which was indeed an affirmation of AFRO's work. The funding allows AFRO to provide diversified services for female sex workers, including but not limited to outreach, testing, hotline, case work, centre activities and public education. These services not only improved the physical and mental health of sex workers, but also increased the awareness of their rights, as well as promoted the understanding and acceptance of sex workers by the general public.

Although we faced many challenges last year, one of which was the shortage of manpower, the AFRO team demonstrated their professionalism to ensure smooth running of the centre. We would like to express our sincere gratitude to all colleagues and volunteers, including Ms. Sylvan Pang, who has worked with us for more than 10 years before she left AFRO in mid-2019. The dedication and efforts of the team have contributed significantly to the sustainable development of AFRO.

雖然現今社會對性工作的了解漸多,但大衆對性工作者的歧見並未消減,這樣的社會氛圍窒礙了她們主動發聲和敢於爭取自己的權益。另外,過去數年,性工作這行業從經營方式以至從業員已有很顯著的變化。性工作這行業流動性大,易受社會因素影響。故此,青鳥團隊除了繼續推廣性健康檢查、教育、法律及權益倡議工作外,亦會與社會各界別溝通和交流,創造一個公平的環境、發展更適切的服務,以回應服務使用者的需要。

世界在變但我們的初心不變。在未來一年我們將繼續以青鳥的信念與性工作者同行。

While the society has gained more understanding of sex work, the stigma attached to sex workers has yet diminished. Such a social atmosphere has prevented sex workers from seeking services they needed or speaking out for their rights. Moreover, it is observed that the sex work industry has changed over the past few years. Sex work industry is highly mobile and vulnerable to social factors. Therefore, in additional to promoting sexual health screening, education, legal and rights advocacy, AFRO will also communicate with all sectors of the community, aiming to create a fair environment and develop appropriate services in respond to the needs of our service users.

Our resolution will not change despite the changing times. In the coming year, AFRO will continue to walk with sex workers with our vision and mission.

本年度工作摘要 Highlights of the Year

- 多年以來, 青鳥都堅持以 整全的角度,關顧性工作 者的服務及發展需要。在 7/2018-6/2019年度,我們 有幸持續獲愛滋病信託基 金、禁毒基金及蘋果日報 慈善基金資助,在綜合服 務的框架下進行相關工作, 透過外展、網上外展、中 心活動、測試服務、熱線、 個案跟進、輔導及轉介等 不同形式,全方位地向性 工作提供性健康、婦女健 康、精神健康、毒品教育、 職業安全、法律及人權相 關之資訊、教育、服務及 支援。
- Over the years, we insisted on caring for the services and development needs of sex workers from a holistic perspective. In 7/2018-6/2019, we are fortunate to be continuously funded by the AIDS Trust Fund, Beat Drugs Fund and the Apple Daily Charitable Foundation to carry out related work.
- Within the framework of integrated services, through outreach, online outreach, centre activities, testing Services, hotlines, case follow-ups, counselling and referrals, we provide sexual health, women's health, mental health, drug education, occupational safety, legal and human rights related information, education, services and support in all aspects for sex workers.


 Although from 7-12/2018, due to lack of manpower, our work progress was slightly affected, resulting in a decrease in the overall service statistics of 7/2018-6 /2019 compared with the previous year. However, thanks to the staff team and the volunteers. All funded projects were still successfully completed as scheduled.

At the same time, we are, as always, sharing our observations and understandings on the sex workers' community through participating in school lectures, media interviews, providing internship opportunities, hosting public education workshops, volunteer training, and professional training, to strive for public recognition and support for the equal human rights of sex workers.




外展接觸性工作者人次 (按國籍)


No. of Outreach Contacts with Sex Workers (by nationality) (7/2018-6/2019)



外展接觸性工作者人次 (按工作場所) No. of Outreach Contacts with Sex Workers (by workplace) (7/2018-6/2019)




服務中心接觸性工作者人次 (按國籍) No. of Centre-based Contacts with Sex Workers (by nationality) (7/2018-6/2019)






服務中心接觸性工作者人次 (按工作場所) No. of Centre-based Contacts with Sex Workers (by workplace) (7/2018-6/2019)

 As for advocacy, we understand the importance of uniting our peers, and for many years we have worked closely with multiple sex worker support groups, the member groups of Hong Kong Women's Coalition on Equal Opportunities and Hong Kong Coalition of AIDS Service Organizations. In 2018-2019, AFRO, JJJ
Association, Teen's Key and
Midnight Blue maintain regular
meetings with the Crime
Prevention Bureau of the Hong
Kong Police Force, to reflect the
violation of personal safety and
personal privacy encountered
by sex workers in the workplace
and on the Internet, as well as
the various issues that sex
workers may encounter when
interacting with police officers,
and strive for improvement.

- 在倡議的路上,我們深諳團結同行之重要,多年來都與多個性工作者支援團體、平等機會婦女聯席及愛滋病服務機構聯盟的成員團體緊密聯繫。
- 在2018-2019年,青鳥與姐姐 仔會、青躍、午夜藍等團體維 持與警方防止罪案科定期會面, 反映性工作者在工作場所及網 絡上所遇到人身安全及個人私 隱受侵犯之狀況,以及性工作 者與警員接觸時所可能遇到的 各種問題,致力爭取改善。



- 在平等機會婦女聯席這個平台上,我們與其他婦女團體關注 涉及不同婦女(對青鳥而言特別是性工作者)權益的議題。
- 聯席關注到法律改革委員會在 2019年4月底發表《窺淫及未 經同意下拍攝裙底》報告書, 但未涵蓋未經同意網絡散佈私 密影像及針對女性胸部偷拍行 為,促請政府研究立法規管, 以及前線警員加強執法。
- On the platform of Hong Kong Women's Coalition on Equal Opportunities, AFRO and other women's groups pay close attention to women's rights related issues (in AFRO's case especially sex workers).
- At the end of April 2019, the Law Reform Commission of Hong Kong released a report and advocated "the crime of voyeurism" and "the crime of shooting the skirt without consent". The Coalition were concerned that unauthourised distribution of private images on the Internet and sneak shots on women's chests were not covered in the report, thus expressed opinions and urged the government to study legislative regulation, and frontline police officers to strengthen law enforcement.

在2018年7月至2019年6月期間,我們獲多個慈善基金支持,以發展不同方面工作,當中包括愛滋病信託基金、禁毒基金、蘋果日報慈善基金、華人永遠墳場管理委員會及香港美國婦女會等。在此青鳥謹致以由衷謝意。

我們於2018年11月18日舉行慈善義賣,並在2019年4月28日舉行步行籌款,分別籌得港幣12,205元及41,700元,而在2018年7月至2019年6月期間,籌款箱募集得到之善款則共有港幣16,644.2元。
